$4 \times 9 = 36$

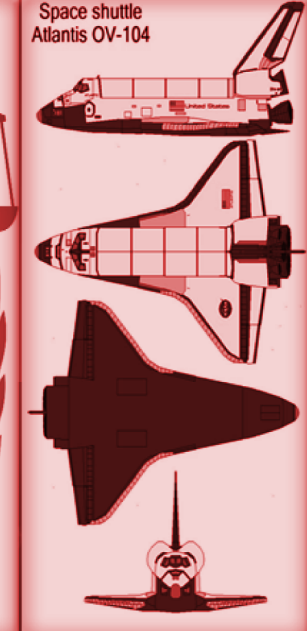
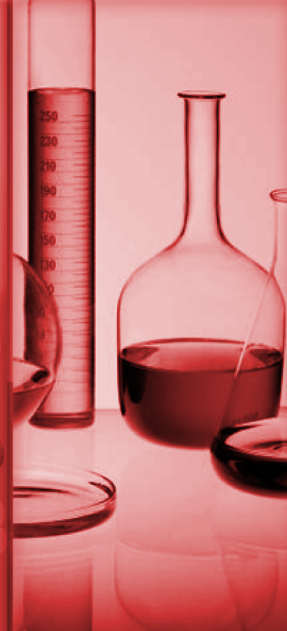

### REMEMBER

**Acquire knowledge:** exhibit memory of previously learned material by recalling basic terms and concepts

**Verbs:** define, describe, list, select, label, match, state, choose, locate, recite

**Questions:** What is ...? When did ...? Which one ...? Who was ...? How did ...? Can you select ...? List the parts of ...?

### UNDERSTAND

**Comprehend knowledge:** Demonstrate understanding of facts and ideas by organizing or comparing main ideas

**Verbs:** compare, contrast, demonstrate, discuss, paraphrase, transform

**Questions:** What is the main idea of ...? What is meant by ...? How would you summarize ...?

### APPLY

**Make use of knowledge:** solve problems in new situations by applying knowledge in new or different ways

**Verbs:** construct, develop, solve, organize, model, collect, prepare, produce

**Questions:** How would you solve ...? What approach do you use to show ...?

### ANALYZE

**Take apart knowledge:** categorize / classify information by identifying parts or components

**Verbs:** analyze, categorize, classify, simplify, survey, infer, differentiate

**Questions:** What are the parts or features of ...? What is the relationship between ...? How would you classify ...?

### EVALUATE

**Judge knowledge:** judge the validity or quality of ideas based on a set of criteria

**Verbs:** appraise, argue, defend, judge, support, value, evaluate, prioritize, assess

**Questions:** How would you prove or disprove ...? Assess the value of ...? What judgment would you make about ...? Why is it better or worse than ...?

### CREATE

**Develop new knowledge:** compile information in a different way by combining elements in a new pattern

**Verbs:** create, design, develop, solve, imagine, write, improve, adapt, theorize

**Questions:** How would you improve ...? What changes would you make to solve ...? Formulate a theory for ...?

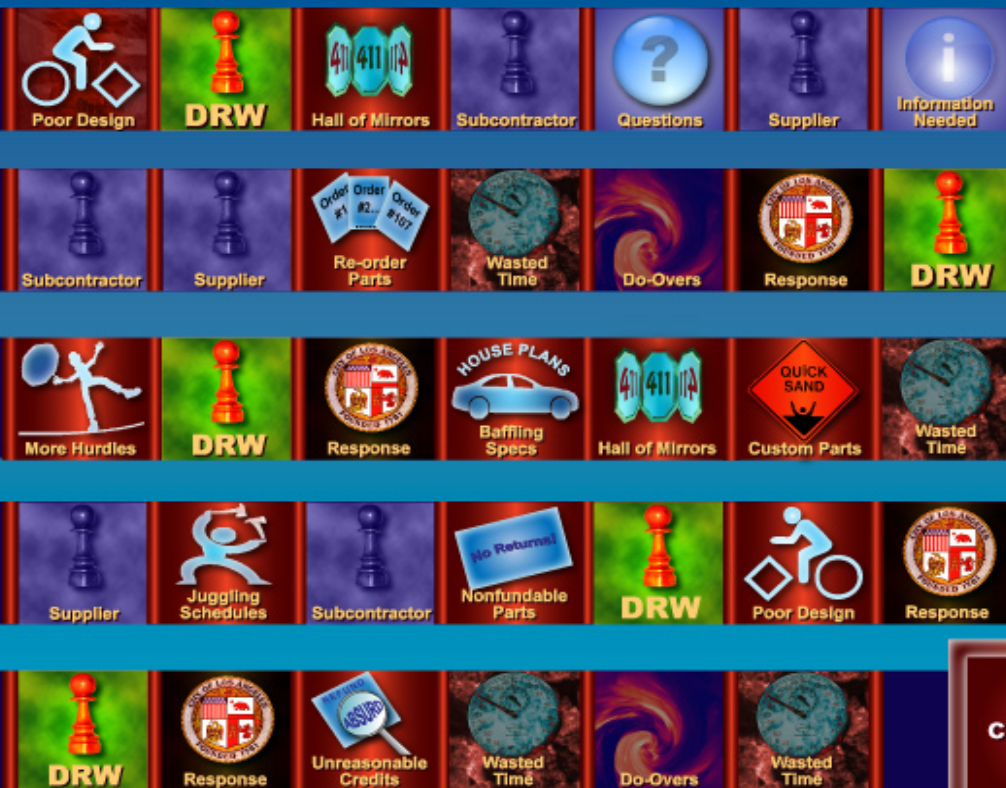
